The Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) recommends Council approval of an Ordinance authorizing and approving a **Substantial Amendment** to the Community Development Block Grant - Disaster Recovery 2015 (CDBG-DR15) Action Plan to allow the transfer of \$7,098,000.00 in Housing (Single Family Home Repair), Planning and Program Administration activity funds to the Public Facilities and Improvements (Infrastructure) activity within the CDBG-DR15 Budget.
