The Housing and Community Development (HCD) Department recommends Council approval of an Ordinance authorizing the submission of the Action Plan for Disaster Recovery – 2021 Winter Storm to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), to receive up to \$30,296,000.00 in Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery 2021 (CDBG-DR21) funds for long-term recovery from the 2021 Winter Storm and to implement mitigation activities. HCD recommends Council approval of an Ordinance authorizing an Agreement between The City of Houston (City) and The Salvation Army, providing up to \$1,193,500.00 in Community Development Block Grant – CARES Act (CDBG-CV) funds to provide diversion services to an additional 350 households who are at risk for immediate homelessness. - b. HCD recommends Council approval of an Ordinance authorizing a First Amendment to the Subrecipient Agreement between the City of Houston and Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston (Catholic Charities) to extend the reimbursement term through September 30, 2022 for Emergency Solutions Grant - CARES Act (ESG-CV), allowing Catholic Charities to request reimbursement for expenditures incurred during the new extended period.
